

## English

Reading: This half term, we will be reading a range of books for pleasure and to support reading comprehension including 'Who Let the Gods Out' by Maz Evans'. We will also be comparing themes and author styles within and across texts as part of guided reading sessions.

## Writing

This half term we will be using 'Feast' and Greek myths as our stimulus for writing. We will be developing our writing accuracy and stamina through sentence focused writing and using authors writing as models for our own.

## Grammar and Punctuation

Much of our grammar and punctuation skills will be taught and practised through our writing in order to contextualise our learning. This term, our learning will include: adverbs and adverbials; phrases; speech dialogue; conjunctions and relative clauses

## History

Our history topic this term will be Ancient Greeks. We will be investigating different aspects of life in ancient Greece, extending our knowledge of and understanding of world history. We will also be using a range of sources to ask and answer questions, and show our understanding of life in the past.

## Science

During this term, our Science topic will be 'Light'. We will be investigating how light travels and how we see using measuring and observing skills. We will also be recording and reporting our findings to help explain what we have found out.

## DT

This term we will be making Greek masks. This will involve generating and communicating ideas through discussion and annotated sketches. We will also be using a range of tools to shape, join and finish

## RE

This term we will be learning about Islam, answering the question: What is the best way for a Muslim to show a commitment to God. This will include recapping learning about the main aspects of the Muslim faith, and how we show commitment in our lives.

## Maths

This term's topics will include learning, consolidating and extending areas of mathematical fluency, reasoning and problem solving, as well as identifying and addressing any areas of revision necessary.

### Year 4

Number and place value including: numbers to 10,000; rounding to the nearest 10 and comparing numbers.

Addition and subtraction including: formal methods for addition and subtraction with 3 and 4 digit numbers; estimating and checking answers.

### Year 5 & 6

Number and Place Value including: numbers to 1,000,000, rounding numbers within 100,000, comparing and ordering numbers; and negative numbers.

Addition, subtraction, Multiplication and Division including: formal methods for all four operations including some work with long division; multiples, factors; and multiplying and dividing by powers of 10.

In all years, we will be taking opportunities to recap areas of learning from the previous year and, where necessary will add additional lessons to ensure learning is consolidated.

## PHSCE

In PHSCE this term, we will be focusing on the topic 'Being Me'. We will be thinking about goals, rights, responsibilities and consequences for our actions. We will also be taking time during the school day, where appropriate, to talk about current worries, problems or questions which may be concerning us.
