Paragraph 1 - Summary

Who is the article about? What happened? When and where?



<u>Paragraph 2 - Details of the story</u> Who was Rosa Parks? What did she do and what happened to her?

Paragraph 3 - What did people think?

What did people think about Rosa Parks' actions? You willneed to use your imagination! For example Jacob, aged 23 said "I think what Rosa Parks did was amazing and changed American history forever!" (Don't forget to use inverted commas!)
