## HELP DESK



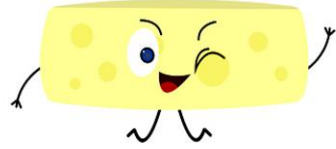
**Assonance:** repeated vowel sounds ('a' 'e' 'i' 'o' 'u') throughout the line/sentence  
E.g. 'The rain in Spain fell on the plain'

**Personification:**  
Describing objects as if they are people  
E.g. 'The stars danced in the night sky'

**Hyperbole:** words used to *exaggerate, intensify* and *emphasise* different ideas  
E.g. 'The pizza was hotter than the sun.'

**Alliteration:**  
Repeating the sounds at the start of words  
E.g. 'Rare red rabbits revel with rage'

**Onomatopoeia:**  
Words that sound like what they describe  
E.g. 'crunch' 'smack' or 'drip'
