Maths/Number & Shape, Space and Measure

Yr R: This term the children will read, write, count & find totals to 10. In practical situations begin to use addition & subtraction, as well as begin to look at length, height, weight and time.

Yr 1: Will count forwards & backwards & write numbers in numerals to 50 and learn about place value to 50. We will also be continuing with addition & subtraction to 20 reasoning and problem solving.


Each week Y1 we will have a fluency focus. This is a quick 2 minute test that will include questions about number bonds to 5 and 10 and adding 1 or 2 to a number.

Science/UtW

We will continue to learn about weather and the seasons. We will also be looking at identifying and naming a variety of animals and discovering if they are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will learn to be able to describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals. We will also be describing the simple properties of a variety of everyday materials, as well as comparing and grouping together a variety of everyday materials based on their simple properties.

Geography/UtW

Throughout the term we will be exploring maps and features of the local area. We will be looking at both the school and the area surrounding the school.

Art, Design and Technology/EA&D

During our art sessions we will be looking at the variety of paper available to us and the techniques and skills we can use to create a range of art work, models and sculptures, including stained glass windows, beads and paper mache.

RE/U+W

English/Literacy/C&L

Yr R: We will continue to learn our Letters & Sounds and then write our names, labels, lists and captions using our phonics to write words that match our spoken language. We will be using our cursive handwriting letter formation.

Yr 1: We will continue to practise our cursive letter formation, our phonics and our spellings. We will continue to reinforce our handwriting, capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our writing. We will be reading stories from other cultures; writing labels, lists and captions to support our non core curriculum subjects.

We will continue to read as a class, in pairs and groups for our guided reading sessions.

Music/EA&D

We will use the Charanga music scheme unit - Everyone!

PE Mr Wall takes our formal PE lesson on Tuesdays.

PSHE/PSED

During our PSHE sessions we will be looking at Dreams and Goals and we will be looking at how to stay motivated, stay positive and work well with others.
