TEAMS Remote Learning

Great Wishford CEVA Primary School's code of conduct

for remote learning

- All queries regarding Remote Learning to be directed through our usual contact address admin@greatwishford.wilts.sch.uk
- School staff will only use school email addresses to send meeting invites to participants.
- The lesson will only go ahead if more than one pupil is present.
- The teacher, as the host, will admit children into the live lesson.
- Pupils should complete the lesson in a shared place in the home.
- Pupils must wear appropriate clothing for the lesson, smart casual. Pajamas and onesies are not appropriate.
- Pupils should work on a desk or table.
- Pupils are expected to remain focused on remote lessons. Children need to be in a quiet place to learn and parents/siblings are encouraged not to interact with pupils during remote teaching.
- Students should turn off the microphone function until they are asked to speak. The hand up function allows the teacher to see who would like to engage in the lesson or ask for help.
- The children should not record or take photos of their classmates or teachers during a face-to-face session
- The children should not share any school content on social media platforms.
- If technology permits we ask that children use the blurring facility on TEAMs; we understand this is not possible on all devices. If the technology will not permit please be aware of background information being shared.
- We expect children to attend all live lessons they are invited to but understand that some children are sharing devices within the family. The TEAMS app can be downloaded on tablets, smart phones and computers.
- Live lessons will not be recorded.
- If lessons are going to be missed parents must let teachers know by contacting
 admin@greatwishford.wilts.sch.uk
 Teachers will contact parents about lesson content and the
 catch up work parents will be expected to support with.
- Teachers will not be available to chat with parents after live lessons.

Lessons will appear in the class channels. We would ask parents to work with their children to explore the class page so new lessons are not missed

Please bear with any technical hitches as we learn alongside the children. We are looking forward to exploring the 'Live events' feature on TEAMS to deliver new learning and responses to learning to the children.
