Thank you for your patience with getting to grips with the new systems we now have in place in school. Below is a reminder of what each one is used for:

WisePay – Anything that has money involved will be processed through this platform and parents have been provided with a login.

ESchools – This gives you access to the secure pages of our website where you can view the class pages, homework etc using your child's login. You also have a parent login which enables you to access information on attendance, parents evening bookings etc.

Parentmail – All emails and text messages from school will come through on this platform. This replaced our previous system Call Parents and all parents should have been contacted directly to sign up to this.
